How is the Organ Mountains-Desert Peaks National Monument (OMDP) important to your business?

In 2013, the Las Cruces Green Chamber of Commerce (LCGCC) commissioned a non-partisan economic impact study that showed positive economic growth to our community with the designation of OMDP. Local businesses became "thoughtful stewards" of OMDP, creating monument themed products and services to cross brand OMDP into their business.

After creating the OMDP Marketing Toolkit, LCGCC staff traveled the country, sharing with communities the successful efforts of Las Cruces residents and businesses embracing their Monument.
